Second Chance for Georgia Campaign

STRENGTHEN THE ECONOMY



The economy would regain the \$87 billion in GDP and 1.9 million workers that are lost when people with a criminal history are excluded from the labor market.

INCREASE PUBLIC SAFETY



In Illinois, steady employment led to a 62% reduction in recidivism among individuals with a record.

REDUCE BARRIERS



4.3 million people face lifetime barriers due to Georgia's narrow law.

INCREASE EMPLOYMENT




A University of Michigan study found that a cleared record increased likelihood of employment by 11% and wages by 22% within the first year.

 Term used in some states for record clearing

❖ Background checks

- GCIC official record, get at law enforcement agencies
- Private Background Checks most employers & landlords use, data from court records

❖ Restriction & Sealing

- Restriction limits access to GCIC report
- Sealing limits access to court records

Pardon

 Certificate of forgiveness from the state

❖ First Offender

 If successfully complete sentence not a conviction, deferred adjudication

What SB 288 Does...

...for people with a criminal history?

- Provides for restriction & sealing of certain misdemeanor convictions
 - Up to 2 convictions
 - 4 years after completion of sentence
 - Crime-free for 4 years
 - Court process

❖Allows an individual who received a pardon for certain **felony** offenses to petition a court to restrict & seal their record

Discharge and seal

❖ Pending Cases

Restrict and seal dead dockets

❖ Non-convictions

Restrict and seal

Limits what you will see on a background

- ❖ Provides **liability protection** by limiting the admissibility of evidence if...
 - Info was not relevant
 - Info was restricted & sealed or pardoned
 - Arrest did not result in a conviction
